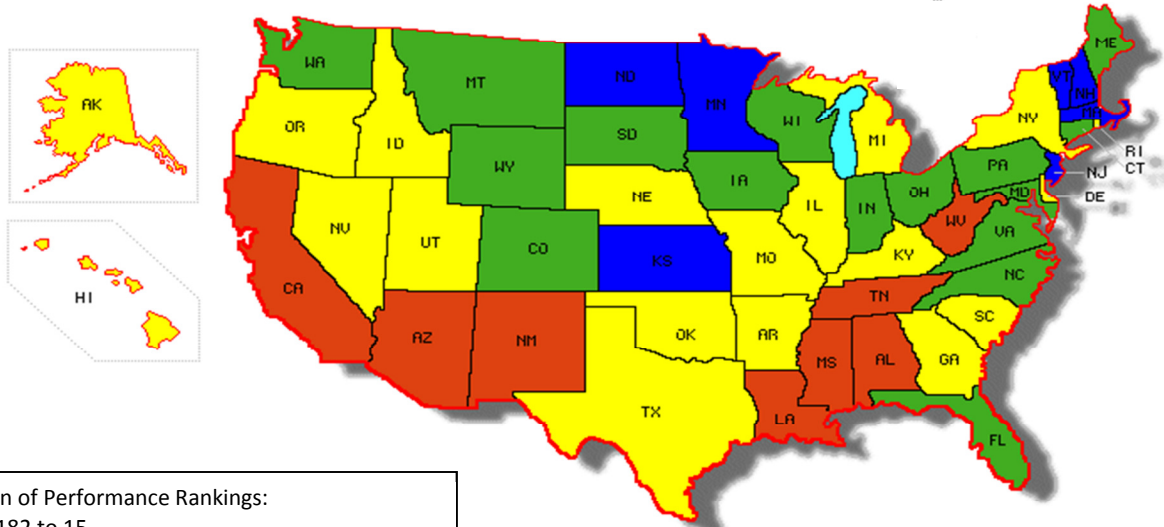


Mapping NCES Statistics for 50 States and DC

Performance - Colorado performs better than Utah though not as well as Kansas. This is based upon NAEP and is not reflective of Colorado achievement and accreditation goals.

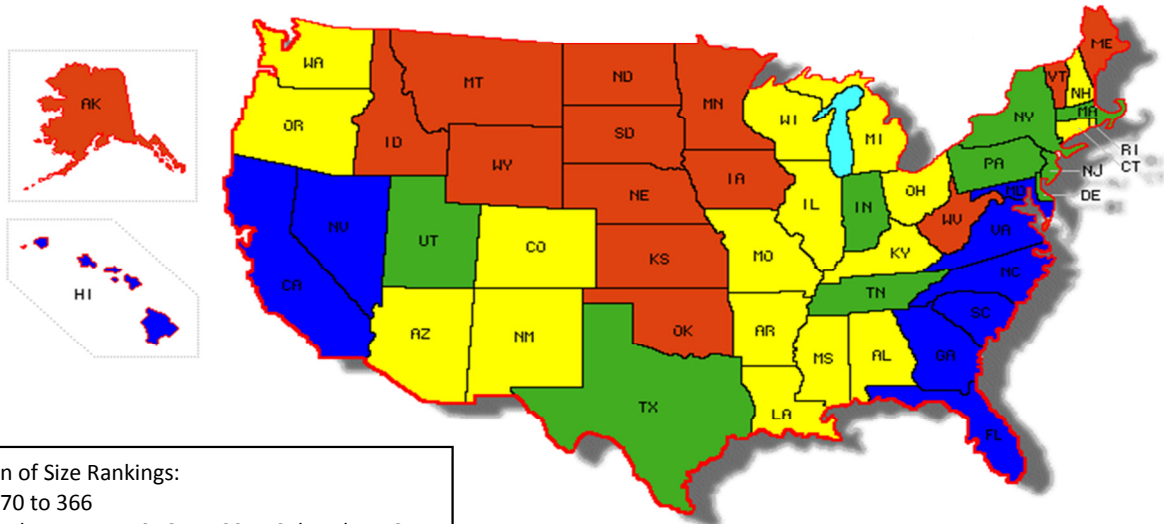


Description of Performance Rankings:
