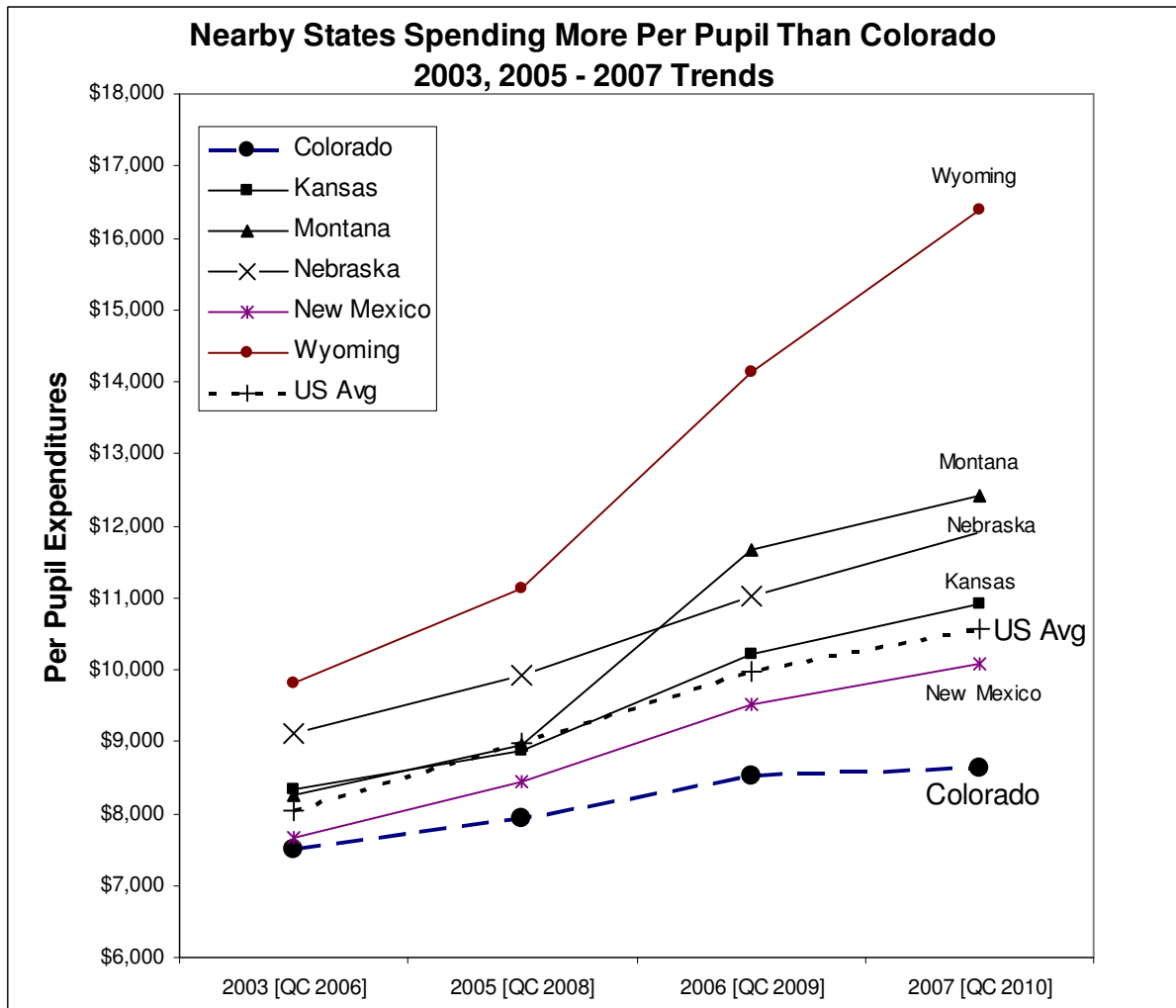

Per Pupil Expenditure¹: Comparing Colorado spending to National Average:

Colorado spent:

- \$1,919 less than the national average in 2007-08
- 1,449 less in 2006-07
- \$1,034 less in 2005-06
- \$551 less in 2003-04
