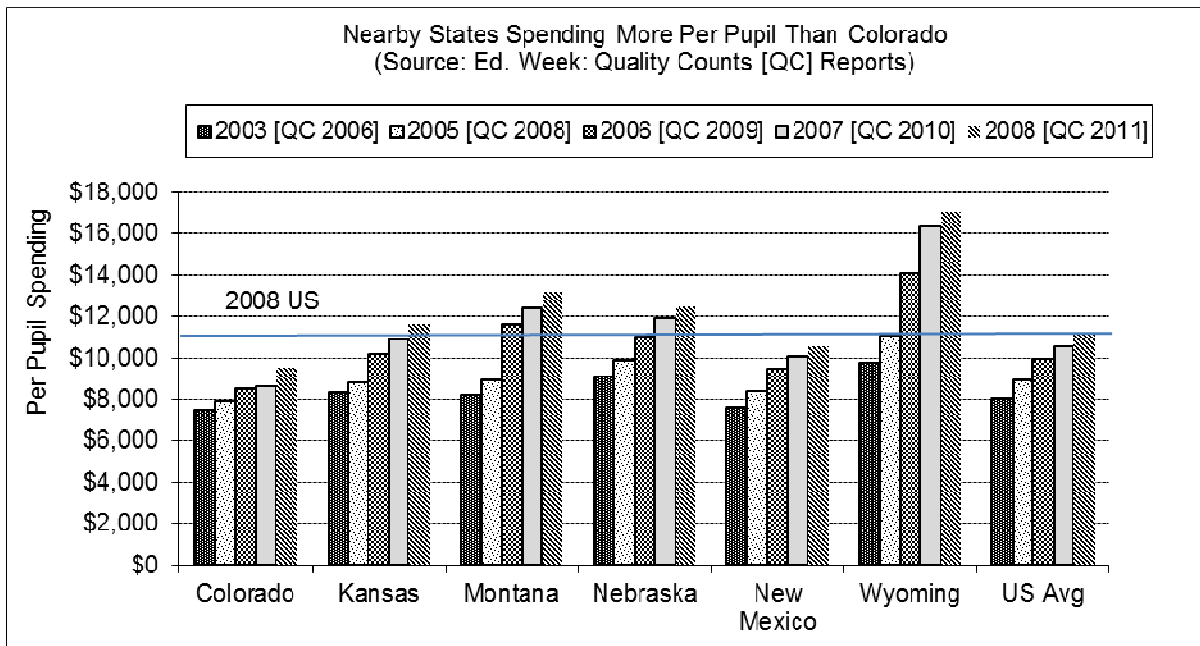

Per Pupil Expenditure: Comparing Colorado spending to National Average:



Colorado per pupil spending less than the national average:

-\$1,682 less in 2008

-\$1,034 less in 2005

-\$1,919 less in 2007

-\$551 less in 2003

-\$1,449 less in 2006

Quality Counts 2011: Per Pupil Expenditure (2008 data) more than Colorado:

1. Kansas spent \$2,139 more per pupil.
2. Montana spent \$3,687 more per pupil.
3. Nebraska spent \$2,950 more per pupil.
4. New Mexico spent \$1,052 more per pupil.
5. Wyoming spent \$7,573 more per pupil.

Quality Counts 2008: Per Pupil Expenditure (2005 data) more than Colorado:

1. Kansas spent \$923 more per pupil.
2. Montana spent \$1,012 more per pupil.
3. Nebraska spent \$1,991 more per pupil.
4. New Mexico spent \$492 more per pupil.
5. Wyoming spent \$3,187 more per pupil.

Quality Counts 2010: Per Pupil Expenditure (2007 data) more than Colorado:

6. Kansas spent \$2,285 more per pupil.
7. Montana spent \$3,786 more per pupil.
8. Nebraska spent \$3,265 more per pupil.
9. New Mexico spent \$1,452 more per pupil.
10. Wyoming spent \$7,748 more per pupil.

Quality Counts 2006: Per Pupil Expenditure (2003 data) more than Colorado:

1. Kansas spent \$844 more per pupil.
2. Montana spent \$758 more per pupil.
3. Nebraska spent \$1,627 more per pupil.
4. New Mexico spent \$178 more per pupil.
5. Wyoming spent \$2,231 more per pupil.

Quality Counts 2009: Per Pupil Expenditure (2006 data) more than Colorado:

1. Kansas spent \$1,702 more per pupil.
2. Montana spent \$3,146 more per pupil.
3. Nebraska spent \$2,509 more per pupil.
4. New Mexico spent \$1,011 more per pupil.
